**Program Type :** Young Explorer


**Intake:** 15 Children per batch (max) Min intake – 8 participants

**Age Group:** 10 to 17 years to adults

**Program Highlight:** Moderate to difficult Night Trek/ Camping under stars

**Skills Targeted:** Resilience / Independence & Team work

Kalsubai is the highest peak in Maharashtra, rising proudly to an altitude of 5,400 feet (1,646 meters) in the Western Ghats. Located in the Ahmednagar district, it offers breathtaking views of nearby forts like Alang, Madan, and Kulang, and the lush green expanse of the Bhandardara region. The trek is a mix of rocky paths, iron ladders, and scenic trails, making it suitable for both beginners and seasoned trekkers. At the summit stands the revered Kalsubai temple, attracting pilgrims and adventure enthusiasts alike. With its mix of natural beauty, spiritual energy, and physical challenge, Kalsubai is a must-do experience in Maharashtra.



## Program Itinerary

Day 1 -Arrive at Bari base village at 5 to 6 pm.

Freshen up at our homestay partner and start trekking by 7 pm.

The trek takes 2.5 to 3 hours to Kalsubai top. Tent allocation, dinner and overnight at Campsite.

Day 2 – Wake up at 5 am and take a short trek to top. Spend an hour viewing sunrise and descend.

Breakfast and descend – Sunday 12 noon
