Prabalgarh, also known as Kalavantin Durg's twin, is a majestic hill fort nestled between Matheran and Panvel in Maharashtra. Standing at an elevation of around 2,300 feet, it offers stunning panoramic views of the Sahyadri range and surrounding forts like Irshalgad and Karnala. The trek to Prabalgarh is moderately challenging, with dense forest trails, rocky patches, and a rewarding summit plateau ideal for camping. Rich in Maratha history, it once served as a watchtower during Shivaji Maharaj's reign. The experience blends adventure, nature, and heritage, making it a perfect weekend escape for thrill-seekers and nature lovers.



Program Itinerary

Day 1 -Arrive at Prabalgarh base village at 4.30 to 5 pm

Start trekking – trek takes 1.5 hours to base village where campsite is located.

Tent allocation, followed by activities and campfire .Overnight at Campsite

Day 2 – Wake up at 4 am and night trek to top. Spend an hour viewing sunrise and descend.

Breakfast and Check out – Sunday 12 noon
